



## How to prepare a mockup for printing (Digital transfer FULL)

- 1. The white field is the area of the 488x330mm sheet on which your design will be printed.
- 2. The blue box delimited by the red dotted line is the 470x295mm printing area. It is in this area that you should place your graphics. Do not exceed this area - this will prevent the printed graphics from being cut off or damaged by mechanical elements during printing.
- 3. Mirror image of all graphics required;
- 4. An overlay (applique) is required around each logotype of 0.8mm in the colour of the material to which the logotypes will be applied.
- 5. The colour of the appliqué should be made using CMYK colours
- 6. Logotypes may contain tonal transitions.
- 7. Logotypes must not contain shadows.
- 8. The minimum required resolution of the graphics is 300 dpi. Graphics sent at a lower resolution may result in lower print quality.
